Subject: Security Report for the Month of February 2010

OPERATIONS

Our injured Gate Officer has returned home and is resting comfortably. She may be off for approximately 12 weeks.

The North Gate visitor gate arm has finally been repaired. Some bolts failed that hold the motor housing together, which caused some gear damage. After the motor housing was repaired and replaced, there were still problems that required the service technician to return multiple times. These problems have been fixed. I am in the process of getting bids for a back up gate arm and barcode reader.

INCIDENTS OF NOTE

February 7, Sunday, 11:00 a.m., overnight a window was broken on a car that was parked in the driveway on Leyenda Court.

February 8, Monday, 3:53 p.m., a group of juveniles were observed behind an unoccupied house on Rio Oso. A rear porch door was found open and a baggie containing possible marijuana was found on the porch. A person responsible for the house was contacted and the porch door was secured.

February 10, Wednesday, 4:26 p.m. and 5:09 p.m., two reports of gunshots were made in the area of Reynosa Drive and Riverview Park. Security Patrol Officers and Sacramento County Sheriff's Deputies (SSD) searched the area, but heard nothing.

February 11, Thursday, 7:50 p.m., a non-injury accident occurred on Cantova Way. California Highway Patrol (CHP) responded for a report.

February 12, Friday, 8:27 a.m., overnight two windows were broken on the Rancho Murieta Association (RMA) building. The windows are on the Murieta Parkway side and the damage was done possibly by a pellet gun. A SSD report was filed.

February 12, Friday, 6:40 p.m., a complaint of drug use at the Clementia Park Amphitheater. Area checked clear.

February 13, Saturday, 11:50 p.m., complaint of two unknown subjects sitting in a car in front of a house. Two juveniles contacted who had been drinking. Parents contacted and retrieved kids.

February 14, Sunday, 12:14 a.m., Trinidad Drive, complaint of juveniles lighting fireworks and shooting house with paintballs. Area checked, unable to locate.

February 14, Sunday, 8:26 a.m., Lago Drive, tires were slashed on a car that was parked in the driveway.

February 21, Sunday, 4:29 p.m., Guadalupe Drive, a report that dog feces was put on a car that was parked in the driveway.

February 24, Wednesday, 9:20 a.m., Cazador, report of a juvenile looking into a back door and open side garage door. Fled when confronted by neighbor. SSD notified and given possible suspect information. SSD contacted the juvenile on Puerto Drive who was home sick from school. Juvenile admitted walking through the yard. Parent notified.

During the month of February, Security received various complaints of a toilet paper job, doorbell ditching, loud music, parties, and juveniles.

The Committee met on February 22, 2010. There was one scheduled hearing on driveway parking where the resident did not show and six letters submitted regarding street parking, speeding, driveway parking, and stop signs.
